## **CASE DISMISSED AGAINST HOLO LIMITED**

The District Court in California has dismissed the case brought against Holo Limited, et. al. by 19 Tao Vega.

19 Tao Vega invented a fantastical story claiming the rights to HoloChain in an attempt to access our funds and to delay or prevent the shipping of the initial hardware which represent distributed hosting nodes on Holo network. These HoloPorts were in part, pre-purchased by supporters of the Holo Indiegogo campaign in 2017 and presales on the company's online store. A Federal Circuit Court Judge considered material facts and arguments by both the complainant and Holo regarding trademark use and an alleged breach of contract, and denied the injunction before dismissing the case.

Holo has applied for and received preliminary or full approval of trademarks globally related to the open-source HoloChain project as well as the HoloPort, HoloFuel and the name Holo as they pertain to the hardware, software and platform services they represent.

Holo is preparing to ship HoloPorts to the pre-purchasers by the end of 2019 and this will open the Alpha testing period of the distributed network to all hosts who will provide peer-to-peer hosting of distributed applications.
